(Row 7) 5 McIntosh, 4 Crimson Crisp, 5 Snowsweet, 12 Sansa

(Row 9) 2 McIntosh, 8 Crimson Crisp, 4 Snowsweet, 13 Smokehouse Mixed Area #2: 1-2 trees of Chestnut, Red Yorking and Hardy Cumberland.

Mixed Area #3: 1 Jonagored tree and 2 Enterprise trees.
